MULTIPLE VISITOR VISA REQUIRMENTS for Chinese citizens with substantially high incomes

REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. One completed visa application form
 - You must answer all the questions. If there is nothing to write for a particular question, please write "None" or "N/A".
- 2. One 4.5cm x 3.5cm passport sized photo
 - It has to be taken within the past 6 months. White background only.
- 3. **Valid passport (MRP/e-passport** in compliance with the ICAO standard only)
- 4. Your current Australian VEVO Visa information
 - -Visa Status Confirmation from the Visa Entitlement Verification Online (**VEVO**) System **Bridging visa A is not acceptable. Please obtain **bridging visa B** beforehand
- 5. A copy of E-ticket or confirmed flight details (full flight details from an accredited travel agent or airline) including the following particulars;
 - -Traveler's name
 - -Departure & Arrival dates and time in and out of Japan
- 6. A letter of explanation stating the reason of applying for the multiple-entry visa
- 7. Bank statement
 - Your savings accounts for the last 6 months, but issued not older than 1 month with your name & a current balance
- 8. **Notice of Assessment** from the ATO, which show your <u>annual income</u>
- 9. Copy of **two recent pay slips** or **letter of employment** which show your <u>annual income</u>
- 10. The proof of relationship such as **Marriage certificate** or **Birth certificate** if the applicant applies along with the spouse or children <u>English translation is required</u> when it's written in other languages.

*When an applicant lodges the application separately from the spouse or parent, the document (11.) is necessary instead of (7., 8.and 9.)

11. A copy of the Japanese multiple-entry visa (limited to the same visa category) which spouse or parent hold.

NOTES:

- A person staying in Australia with a tourist/visitor visa can apply for a Japanese visa only in her/his own country.
- The Consulate-General of Japan will not make copies. Documents must be original or certified copies.
- Documents will not be returned. If you need to keep your original documents, please bring the original and one copy.
- Additional documents may be required if necessary.
- Processing time is roughly **5 business days**; however, it may take longer depending on the situation.
- There is NO priority processing service. Therefore, early preparation for visa application is highly recommended.
